Eligibility Criteria

- o A Secondary degree (high school diploma/global equivalent),
- o 60 months (minimum 5 years) of project management experience in leading and directing projects, AND
- o 35 contact hours of formal project management education/training or CAPM® certification

OR

- o A tertiary degree (bachelor's degree or global equivalent),
- o 36 months (minimum 3 years) of project management experience in leading and directing projects, AND
- o 35 contact hours of formal project management education/training or CAPM® certification

All project management experience must have been accrued within the last eight consecutive years prior to your application submission. All contact hours of formal project management education must be completed at the time you submit the application.
