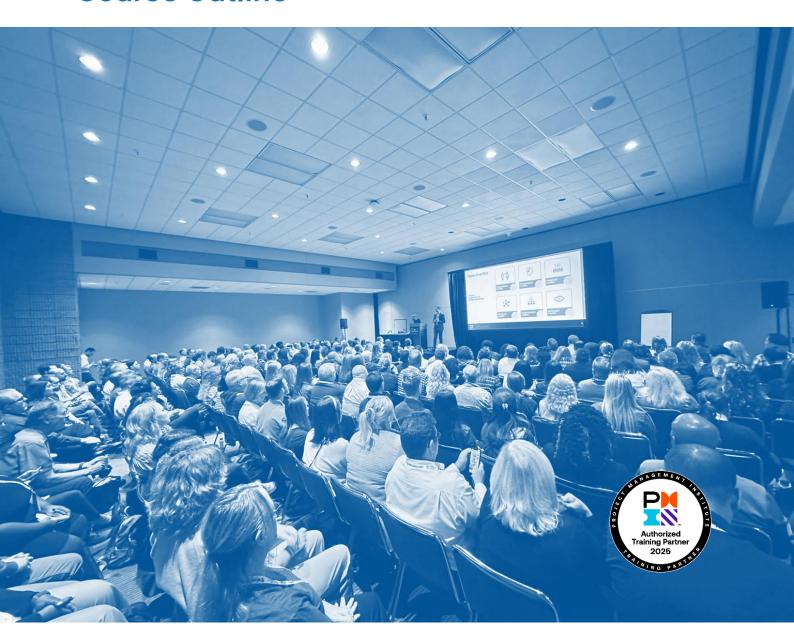

Course Description

Designed for PMP-certified professionals seeking to advance their careers, this intensive 2-day training program bridges the gap between project execution and strategic leadership.

Portfolio Management	 Develop an understanding of portfolio management principles to optimize resource allocation and strategic alignment. Assess and prioritize projects within a portfolio to maximize business value and return on investment.
Program Management	 Understand the role of program management in coordinating interrelated projects to achieve strategic objectives. Apply program management best practices to enhance benefits realization and stakeholder engagement.

Module	Objectives
Authentic and effective leadership and the importance of relationships	 Understand the key aspects of authentic and effective leadership. Apply practical steps to help build strong relationships, create healthy team dynamics, and engage numerous team member personalities.
Decision Making	 Analyze and evaluate the impact of cognitive biases, risk perception, and ethical considerations on individual and group decision-making processes. Demonstrate the ability to apply Systems thinking when managing uncertainty and mitigating loss aversion.
Conflict management and difficult conversations	 Apply skills to promote team cohesion, engagement and project success through inclusive leadership practices. Identify the impact of bias on leadership dynamics and explain its manifestations within project teams.
Organizational Change Management	 Understand the foundational principles of change management and practical tools required to drive successful organizational change. Develop an effective strategy and action plan to drive organizational change.
